Sub Improvements and Key Expenditures

- Pruned back over growth along walking paths.
- Replaced dead Hicks Yews Shetland entrance.
- Mulched the entire community (248 yards).
- Removed dead tree at park.
- Replaced pond bubbler motor. Since installing the ponds are healthier and have had less algae.
- Repaired park bridge from tree damage.
- Grinding of tree stumps along 11 mile road left over from the DTE Energy tree trimming.
- Repaired several mailboxes that had heaved/leaning from over the winter.
- Removed some Junipers from islands-full of grass/tree seedlings etc. Makes for a cleaner appearance.
- Fragmites in front of boardwalk along 11 Mile to be cut down for the winter making it safer for kids to walk to school and cuts down on boardwalk vandalism.
- Garbage along 11 mile road and throughout the community routinely picked up.
- Waste containers placed on boardwalk along 11 Mile, cuts down on litter in woods.
- Boat, trailer and camper violations are down due to increased BOD monitoring in the community, Briden issuing violation warnings and help from the South Lyon Ordinance Officer.
- Retaining wall at Corral pond replaced.
- Replacement of street sign posts and stop signs make for a fresh look increasing our property values.
- Removal of 3 dying boulevard trees at Shetland Entrance.
- Restocked hundreds of fish for the large pond.
- New streamlined process for getting architectural approvals within days!
- Homeowners are investing in their properties once again by doing home improvements.
- Budget well under control and now have an adequate reserve.
- Delinquency rate continues to be well below industry average.

Future projects may include...

- Replacing entrance up lighting spot lights with LED ones.
- Possible Shetland pond landscaping redo and fountain change.
- Repair and or replace overlooks and bridges in park.
- Working with city to replace dead or missing boulevard trees.
- Tennis court to be sealed, repaired and repainted.
