## **Sub Improvements and Key Expenditures**

- Working to reduce garbage cans and misc. items stored outside of home-against Bylaws
- Entire community got mulched 230 yards!
- Cattails in Shetland Pond were treated so they don't take over the entire pond.
- Added more cuts to the 2 vacant lots to improve visual appearance.
- Planted Spruce tree in Shetland Island to replace fallen one.
- ◆ Park Overlook was leveled and repaired. Other one is scheduled for when water level goes back down. Steps to Gazebo repaired by Briden...saves \$ Briden also removed fallen tree branches in park as well as fixed deck boards and rails...saves \$ ☺
- Replaced 3 sections of sidewalk on commons.
- Chestnut storm water drain got dredged and creek cleaned out of debris to aid in water flow.
- Repaired sink holes in Park Path-Please call/email management company-not Facebook!
- Lawsuits filed on past due homeowners.
- Pruned back over growth along walking paths.
- Fragmites in front of boardwalk along 11 Mile cut down for the winter making it safer for kids to walk to school and cuts down on boardwalk vandalism.
- Garbage along 11 mile road and throughout the community routinely picked up.
- Waste containers placed on boardwalk along 11 Mile, cuts down on litter in woods.
- Boat, trailer and camper violations are down due to increased BOD monitoring in the community, Briden issuing violation warnings and help from the South Lyon Ordinance Officer.
- Homeowners are investing in their properties once again by doing home improvements.
- Budget well under control and now have an adequate reserve.
- Delinquency rate continues to be well below industry average.

## Future projects may include...

- Repair and or replace overlooks and bridges in park (targeted first thing in the spring).
- Power wash 3 bridges, 2 overlooks and the gazebo
- Need Social Committee!
- Working with city to replace dead or missing boulevard trees.
- Tennis court to be sealed, repaired and repainted.
