Dues/Debt Collection

This year the board decided to change the due date of the annual dues to March 1st in a one time payment of \$300 instead of two separate payments. We decided this for 2 reasons...first we were spending too much in printing and postage by sending out bills twice a year. By doing it in one installment we are saving our association approx. \$250 a year. Second, we believe this will avoid the busy holiday season and reduce delinquencies and late fees. Your 2010 bills will be mailed to you by January 1st.

We cut back on our spending significantly and have had to cut out several items this year. Without the full support of every homeowner it is difficult to manage our association at its fullest potential.
