#### **Projects**

During a board walk-around, we noticed some safety issues that needed to be addressed immediately. The playground wood chip/mulch had broken down and no longer provided sufficient cushioning in case of falls, so additional mulch was added - approximately 4" throughout. Also, the first overlook at the park was found to no longer be safe due to damage sustained during tree removal in 2023. Taking into consideration the age of the wood decking, the decision was made to replace the entire overlook. The project used Trex material to maximize our investment's longevity. The cost difference between treated wood and Trex was \$2,200, using the most suitable quote, but the Trex should last many years more than wood. There are several other potential projects throughout this fiscal year and 2026 fiscal year. Below are projects thus far and the cost of each. All projects are within the 2025 budget.



Major Projects this Quarter:

- Entrance Flags (2)- \$66.22
- Hanging Baskets (4)- \$106.00
- Entrance mulch- \$34 (17 bags at \$2)
- Playground mulch- \$2,000 (20 cubic yards)
- Park Overlook- \$7,300
